**Concurrent delays** are used as both a sword and a shield in delay claims. A contractor may use concurrency to defend against a claim for liquidated damages, while the employer may use it to oppose the contractor’s pursuit of delay costs. The question of what is truly a concurrent delay is highly contestable.

**Non-critical delay** can be an equal if not a more contentious area of delay analysis. For example an employer may try to discount the contractor’s entitlement to delay costs associated with an extension of time for delays alleged to be the contractor’s responsibility.

The panel of speakers will, with the aid of worked examples, impart their experiences and views on these hot topics, inviting contributions from the floor.
